## **Available irrigation water increased for 2013**

TURLOCK – The Turlock Irrigation District Board of Directors has voted to increase the amount of available irrigation water for customers during the 2013 Irrigation Season. The vote took place as part of today’s regular Board meeting.

By a 3-2 vote of the Board, the amount of water available this season was increased to a cap of 34 inches per acre, up from 30 inches. The irrigation season began March 7 and is scheduled to run through October 9.
