Hilmar High School Wins \$3,000 in TID's Energy Efficiency Video Contest

TURLOCK – There's nothing like a little friendly competition and that's just the theme Hilmar High students used to create this year's winning video for TID's 'Take Action' Energy Efficiency Video Contest.

The winning video is titled, "Leadership Energy" and chronicles the Johnson family's efforts to become more energy efficient than their neighbors, the Smiths. The two minute video promotes TID's Home Energy Analysis and Refrigerator Recycling Program.

This is the second year of TID's annual high school video contest where area schools are invited to submit short videos promoting refrigerator recycling, the Home Energy Analysis Program, shade trees or energy efficient refrigerators.

The Hilmar team consisted of Sophia Dahlin, Jocelyn Gallegos, Julia Johnson and Marco Romo and was led by their teacher, Dianna de Matos. For their efforts, the winning team members split a lump sum of \$1,000 and Hilmar High is awarded \$3,000.

Videos were judged by a five-member panel according to criteria that included an entry's accuracy of information, creativity, use of humor, and use of videography. The top three videos are featured on TID's website at <u>tid.org/news-resources/videos</u> and also on TID's <u>YouTube</u> channel.

Whitmore Charter High School placed second in the contest with a video about energy efficient refrigerators, and another Whitmore High team video about shade trees earned third place. The District expects to roll out the video contest to high schools again next fall, with the hope of increasing the number of entries.

The Home Energy Analysis is a new program giving TID customers the ability to gauge the effectiveness of their energy efficiency efforts by providing them the average energy use of homes similar in size and age. This new service is provided to our customers free of charge.
