



Don Pedro Recreation Agency Encourages Fishing on September 8, 2012

In conjunction with the **California Department of Fish and Game's "Free Fishing Day"** on **September 8, 2012**, the **Don Pedro Recreation Agency will waive the vehicle day use charge for anglers at Don Pedro Lake.**

The intent is to encourage people to take part in recreational fishing, whether it's something they choose to do often or if it's to try it for the first time.

On the September 8, 2012 "Free Fishing Day", not only are California Fishing Licenses not required, the shoreline areas within the developed recreation facilities of Fleming Meadows, Blue Oaks and Moccasin Point Recreation Areas will be available for fishing at no charge for vehicles. Anglers wishing to launch a boat and fish will only be subject to the boat day use fee of \$8.00.
