# Heightened Flows on the Tuolumne River

TURLOCK – The Tuolumne River is running at a heightened flow condition resulting in increased river levels and colder, swifter conditions and currents. Increased flows in the river are required annually as part of the license requirements to operate Don Pedro Dam.

These conditions will vary in intensity through April 25, 2014.

TID is asking everyone to please use caution on or around all area waterways and especially the Tuolumne River as river flows can rise or fall quickly at any time.
