Start of TID irrigation season rescheduled

TURLOCK – Due to changing weather conditions, the start of Turlock Irrigation District’s 2011 irrigation season has been tentatively adjusted to begin March 17, which could also be rescheduled dependent upon weather conditions.

Earlier this week, the District’s Board of Directors authorized a resolution to begin irrigation season on March 10 and conclude it October 19. However, the resolution also authorized TID’s Water Distribution Department Manager to adjust the season as necessary based on weather or crop conditions.
