Turlock Irrigation District delays the start of Irrigation Season

TURLOCK –Recent weather has allowed TID to postpone the beginning of the irrigation season to April 3, 2014 from the previously scheduled start date of March 27th. The season is now set to begin April 3rd and conclude on October 8, 2014. TID’s Water Distribution Department Manager may adjust the end of the season as necessary, depending on weather or crop requirements.

The Water Distribution Department will begin accepting orders for water on April 2, 2014 with deliveries scheduled for April 3rd. To order irrigation water beginning April 2, 2014 call the TID Water Call Center at (209) 883-8456.
