TID plans to extend 2011 irrigation season

TURLOCK – The Turlock Irrigation District plans to extend this year’s irrigation season to run through Wednesday, November 2. This date is contingent upon weather conditions, and the District’s Water Distribution Department Manager is authorized to adjust the season as necessary depending on such conditions.

In this scenario, the final day to place an irrigation order for the 2011 season would be Sunday, October 30. Through that date, growers would be able to place orders by calling the District’s Call Center at (209) 883-8456.

This year’s irrigation season officially began March 17. Original plans called for the 2011 irrigation season to conclude October 19.
