# RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES BETWEEN TID, TWPA AND SIEMENS GAMESA RENEWABLE ENERGY

WHEREAS, due to the Senvion bankruptcy, the Tuolumne Wind Project Authority (TWPA) does not currently have a long term agreement for operations and maintenance of the 20 Senvion turbines in the Tuolumne Wind Project (TWP) due to Senvion's breach of contract; and

WHEREAS, it is in TWPA's best interest to mitigate the elevated risks associated with the 20 Senvion turbines due to their age by entering into a long term operations & maintenance agreement with Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy (SGRE); and

WHEREAS, there are benefits associated with consolidating the operations and maintenance of all 62 TWP turbines to one service provider.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission of the Tuolumne Wind Project Authority that the Operations and Maintenance Agreement between the Tuolumne Wind Project Authority and Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy is hereby approved and the Chief Executive Officer, or her designee, is authorized and directed to execute said Agreement.
