The Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81000, et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730) which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which can be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing it may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference. This regulation and the attached Appendices designating officials and employees and establishing disclosure categories, shall constitute the conflict of interest code of the **Turlock Irrigation District (District)**.

Individuals holding designated positions shall file their statements of economic interests with the **District** who will make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction (Gov. Code Section 81008). Statements for all designated employees will be retained by the **District**.

An individual holding the above listed position may contact the Fair Political Practices Commission for assistance or written advice regarding their filing obligations if they believe their position has been categorized incorrectly. The Fair Political Practices Commission makes the determination whether a position is covered by Section 87200.

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EXHIBIT "B"

DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

Category 1: Investments and business positions in business entities, and sources of income, including loans, gifts, and travel payments, from sources, that provide services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment of the type utilized by the District.

Category 2: Interests in real property located within the jurisdiction or within two miles of the boundaries of the jurisdiction or within two miles of any land owned or used by the District as well as investments and business positions in business entities, and sources of income, including loans, gifts, and travel payments, from sources, that provide real estate consulting or development services of the type utilized by the District.

Category 3: Investments and business positions in business entities, and sources of income, including loans, gifts, and travel payments, from sources, that provide services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment of the type purchased or leased by the department or division in which the designated position works.

Category 4: Investments and business positions in business entities, and sources of income, including loans, gifts, and travel payments, from sources, that filed a claim, or have a claim pending, against the District during the previous two years.

Category 5: Investments and business positions in business entities, and sources of income, including loans, gifts, and travel payments, from sources, of the type to provide financial or insurance services, including, but not limited to, banks, savings and loans, insurance agents, auditors, accountants, and financial hedges and derivatives.
