


TID ENERGY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

available to high school seniors that reside in an income eligible household, pursuing a college degree or trade school certification, with a focus on careers in the energy utility sector.



- Must be a high school senior within TID service territory, that is eligible for graduation.
- Parent/Guardian must be a TID customer.
- Household must be income qualified based on the FASFA Student Aid Index.
- Must plan to attend an accredited college or technical school full time.




