## INVESTING IN Reliability

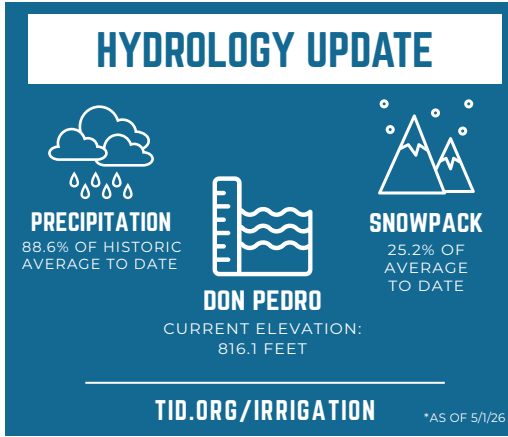

# Spring Showers - Water Year Update

April showers gave the 2025-2026 Water Year a needed boost.

As of May 1, the watershed had received 29.94" of the 33.81" historic September through April precipitation. Snowpack is currently at 25.2% of the May 1 average.



# Illegal Dumping

Cleaning up illegal trash dumps in or around TID canals and facilities ultimately comes at the expense of all our ratepayers, and creates delays in completing other important tasks. # Irrigation Rule 6.8

## Transfer of Water

**6.8.1.** An Irrigator may transfer water from an owned or rented parcel to another parcel which the Irrigator owns or rents provided all of the following conditions are met:

**6.8.1.1.** Both parcels are eligible to receive water, in that they are not in violation of any of District's Rules.

**6.8.1.2.** Any rented parcel from which water is transferred is evidenced by the District records to have been irrigated during any of the prior three irrigation seasons.

**6.8.2.** All documentation for transfers must be approved by the Water Distribution Department and must be completed by December 20th.
