COMMERCIAL PUMP REBATE

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Notify TID when the project is completed and submit the following documentation:
 - Commercial Pumping Rebate Form.
 - Itemized invoice(s) that are paid in full.
 - All manufacturer's specification sheets.
2. TID will then schedule a post-inspection and once approved, the rebate will be paid.

Irrigation Ag Pump

This rebate is for new or retrofit irrigation pumps with a VFD.

To Qualify, pumps must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be equipped with VFD
2. Must be $\leq 25\text{HP}$ and $\geq 300\text{HP}$.
3. Must run a minimum of 500 hours/year

Qualified Equipment Includes:

- Submersible well pump
- Turbine well
- Bowl change
- Overhauled pumps
- Booster Pump
- VFD
- Motor size reduction
- Pump replacement

Clean Water and Wastewater Pump

This rebate is for new or retrofit clean water and wastewater pumps

To Qualify, pumps must meet the following requirements:

1. PEI must be $< .93$
2. Must be $\leq 250\text{HP}$
3. Must be separately metered or annual run time provided
4. Must run a minimum of 500 hours/year

Qualified Equipment Includes:

- New installation of Clean Water or Wastewater pump
- Alteration or expansion project
- Submersible Turbine Pumps

QUALIFICATIONS

Qualifying equipment must be installed and/or operating in facilities served by TID.

Energy efficiency levels of retrofit projects or new construction projects must exceed city code or development requirements as well as all federal and state government-mandated efficiency standards.

Replacement equipment must operate for a minimum of 5 years.

Equipment purchased for inventory or resale does not qualify.

Applications must be completed and submitted prior to scheduling of a post-inspection.

Detailed and dated copies of all invoices must be submitted along with pertinent equipment data and cut sheets before issuance of rebate.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Rebates are provided up to the limit of the rebate or the total cost of purchase and installation, whichever is less.

The Program may be modified, amended or terminated without prior notice, at the sole discretion of TID.

Completed applications are accepted on a first come, first served basis and are processed in the order received until the funds are exhausted or the Program is terminated. The acceptance of an application by TID is not a guarantee of rebate funds.

The applicant must be an active customer of record (Customer) of TID, and must remain so throughout the entire rebate process.

Rebates cannot be assigned or transferred.

Completed applications must be received by TID no later than six (6) months from the purchase date of the equipment in order to be eligible for the program.

Applications that are not complete, without a signature, or without all required documents will neither be processed nor entitle the applicant to be included in the first-come, first-served funding order of the rebate.

TID is not responsible for any items delayed or lost in the mail.

TID disclaims any and all liability for loss or damage which may arise as a result of the customer's participation in this rebate program.
